My name is **Beth Sharp**, and I am one of the founding members of **Cornerstone Collaborative Education (CCE)**. Two years ago, the Lord placed a vision on my heart—a vision for a different kind of educational experience. One that combines the flexibility and personalized attention of a homeschool co-op with the consistency and structure of full-time education.

In today's world, many parents are finding that traditional public schools no longer meet the needs of their children. At the same time, homeschooling or private education can often be out of reach financially or practically. **CCE offers a unique solution**: a full-time educational facility built on a homeschool-style model, providing students with the structure they need and the flexibility families long for.

We are launching **K–12 education**:

- **K–5th grade** will feature a traditional classroom setup with passionate, qualified teachers.
- **Middle and High School** students will participate in high-quality online instruction through **SCOLA**, a program that also allows them to take part in public school sports, clubs, dances, and other extracurriculars.

This innovative partnership is the first of its kind in our area, and we believe it will be a **game-changer** for families in **Georgetown**, where the need for alternative education is urgent.

But we're not stopping there! CCE will also reintroduce **life skills education**, offering classes in:

Automotive | Financial Management/Budgeting | Cooking | Social/emotional growth ...and much more.
